It is with this powerful awareness of our absolute dependence upon our Sovereign and Holy God that these documents are set forth within these bylaws (Ephesians 5:23; Colossians 1:18; 2 Thessalonians 2:15).

Delaware Christian Church has evolved and grown as a congregation since our bylaws were last amended. These bylaws from 1996 do not reflect our present or our future which keeps us from faithfully serving God and his people.

Your DCC leadership has been working on revisions and has been advised by lawyers, church consultants and outside church counsel to make sure the new bylaws are in accordance with the Bible and Ohio State laws.

On Sunday, October 20th, DCC members will be given the opportunity to show their support of the new bylaws. Take the time to read the proposed revisions. The elders will be in room 200 during both services on Sunday, October 6th and 13th to answer questions and share the importance of these changes.
