



## **DCC RE-GATHERING: Weekend of June 20-21st**

We have missed worshipping together as a family and we have been prayerfully considering how to move forward with the recommendations concerning the COVID-19 gathering practices. This has been a season of embracing that what we do is BIGGER than in-person Sunday gatherings!

In the last several weeks, we have monitored guidelines and best practices for gathering in a safe way. After a significant amount of prayer and preparation, the Leadership Team at DCC is excited to share we will resume in-person services the weekend of June 20-21st. To make that possible, our services have been redesigned to create a sanitary, touchless environment that allows for social distancing. Service will be opened with a reduced capacity to allow adequate spacing, so we will ask you to reserve your seat online in advance on behalf of your family. We have added a 3<sup>rd</sup> service on Saturday evening at 6:00 pm to help accommodate everyone and pushed back our 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday service to 10:45 am to allow for more cleaning time in-between services.

We encourage you to make the best choice for your family and situation as you consider attending a physical service or continuing to worship online. You're part of the DCC family no matter where you choose to attend!

In order for us to prepare for your arrival we are making reservations available on a first-come, first-serve basis, until services are fully operational. Reservations open on Wednesdays at 6:00 pm – and close Saturday at 11:59 pm. The link for reserving your seat will be available on the website beginning June 10<sup>th</sup>.

The following Re-gather Strategy and decisions have been made:

### **Re-Gathering Guidelines & General Observations For Your Safety**

#### **Social Distancing**

Observe social distancing at all times

Those who are sick should stay home and worship with us online

Entrance and Exit will flow in a one way pattern throughout the building

Masks are optional

Hugging and hand shaking are discouraged at this time

#### **Safety & Facility Cleanliness**

Touchless sanitizing stations available throughout the building

Cleaning before, in-between, and after services

DCC Café temporarily unavailable

Pre-packed communion

Offering plates will no longer be passed

Secure Offering boxes available in the back of the Worship Center

### **Kids and Students**

At this time, DCC Kids and Student gatherings are not meeting on Sunday mornings

### **High-Risk Rooms**

It is recommended that those 65 and older or at high risk stay home and worship with us online.

However, there will be a room set aside specifically for those who are considered high-risk. This room will have a single point of entrance and exit. Space is limited so registration is important.

### **Entry Time**

Doors will open at 5:50pm on Saturday and at 8:50 am/10:35 am on Sunday

### **Entry and Exit Locations**

Enter through the front main entrance

Exit through the DCA back entrance

Due to the restrictions and guidelines that we are required to follow, many of our rooms and spaces will be unavailable during this time. We respectfully request that everyone follow the guidelines we have implemented as these were created with your safety in mind.
