The **mission and purpose** of the Global Impact Ministry is to empower and Christians to fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ of making disciples of all nations, with a holistic approach that encompasses not only spiritual transformation but also addressing physical, emotional, and social needs.

Matthew 28:19-20 – “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.”

Romans 10:13-15 - “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”

Our Strategy for Global Impact:

1. **Prayer and Discernment:** Prioritize prayer as the foundation of all initiatives seeking God's guidance and discernment in every decision and action.
2. **Partnership Development:** Forge strong partnerships with mission organizations, communities and local churches in target regions, fostering collaboration, mutual respect, and shared ownership of mission efforts. Support these communities through financial means, by sending short-term teams to experience and understand the work of the community served, and providing encouragement to those who are serving.
3. **Holistic Ministry:** Embrace a holistic approach to mission, addressing not only spiritual needs, but also physical, emotional, and social needs through initiatives such as healthcare, education, economic empowerment, and community development.
4. **Long-Term Sustainability:** Focus on sustainable solutions that empower local leaders and communities to continue the work of transformation long after external support diminishes, fostering self-reliance and long-term impact.
5. **Cultural Sensitivity and Humility:** Approach mission work with humility, recognizing the inherent dignity and value of every individual and culture, and seeking to learn from and honor the perspectives and contributions of those served.
